### Rental Assistance

- [☞ Privately Owned Subsidized Housing](#) - HUD helps apartment owners offer reduced rents to low-income tenants.

### Energy Assistance

Our primary purpose is to help Montanans faced with energy emergencies meet their needs and move towards self-reliance. Since its inception in 1982 Energy Share has distributed 10.5 million dollars in energy assistance to more than 34,000 families.
