Jason Petrino was named the 17th head football coach in Rocky Moun-tain College history in January. He came to Rocky in January of 2016 after spending the past four years as the defensive coordinator and defensive backs coach under legendary coach Joe Glenn at the University of South Dakota.



The goal of the Battlin' Bears Youth Football Camp is to teach fundamentals in football according to each position, such as proper blocking and tackling techniques that focus on safety and head placement. It's critical to make sure the head stays out of all contact just like it is taught by the NFL-sponsored Heads Up Football program. Also emphasized will be proper footwork and ball skills that go along with throwing, catching, and running with the football.
