BILLINGS -- Eric Buck, MSUB professor of philosophy, will speak at Rocky Mountain College's Philosophy and Religious Thought Society meeting, Thursday, April 9, 2009, from 4 – 5 p.m., in the Selover Room of Bair Family Student Center. His topic will be "Anarchy: The City and the Philosophy."

Professor Buck has a Ph.D in philosophy from the University of Kentucky. His dissertation was entitled "Making Sense of Architecture: A Philosophical Call For Tectonic Wholeness." He joined the faculty at MSUB in the English and philosophy department in 2006. He is involved in projects on architecture, anarchism, Taoism and phenomenology. He teaches courses in introductory philosophy, history of philosophy, East Asian philosophy, and urban ecology.
