BILLINGS -- Rocky Mountain College is pleased to be able to again offer five scholarships to high school juniors and seniors (Fall 2010) to enroll in CSC130 Fundamentals of Programming I.

As in years past, the course will be offered on the Rocky Mountain College Campus on MWF 2:30 - 3:20 p.m. with a co-requisite lab on Tuesday from 2:30 - 5:20 p.m. As in the past, CSC143, an accelerated curriculum, may be offered for exceptionally advanced students.

Participation in this unique program (currently in its seventh year), that awards fully transferable college credits to students completing the course, has continued to be strong; seven area high school students enrolled in the course last fall and all of them continued enrollment in subsequent coursework in the spring.
