Vicki Davison has been named Rocky Mountain College Director of Major Gifts. Davison was promoted from her previous position as RMC alumni relations and annual fund director.

Davison has a long and successful history working with public service organizations and in fund raising. She helped form the Billings Catholic Schools Foundation from the Billings Area Catholic Education Trust (BACET), serving as executive director of BSC from 2005 until 2008.
