BILLINGS – Dr. Jennifer Lyman, Rocky Mountain College professor of botany and environmental sciences, is the guest speaker at Town & Gown, Wednesday, Oct. 6, 2010.

Dr. Lyman recently spent two years as Director of the Acopian Center for the Environment at the University of Armenia in Yerevan, Armenia. Her topic is “In the Shadow of Arafat: Adventures and Research in Post Soviet Armenia.”

Town & Gown meets in the Montana State University – Billings Student Union Building Lewis & Clark Room with a 6 p.m. social and reception, a 6:45 p.m. dinner and the program at 7:45 p.m. The cost is \$20 per person.

Dr. Lyman has extensive experience as a plant ecologist conducting research and working with botanical colleagues in Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrghistan and Armenia. She has traveled throughout the Russia Far East in her work with plant conservation and botany. At RMC she teaches in the environmental science program and has conducted research on wetlands along the Yellowstone River and the ongoing herbarium collection of plants of the south-central Montana region.

Dr. Lyman received her bachelor’s degree at Wellesley College and her master’s and doctoral degrees at the University of California, Riverside.
