BILLINGS -- Current and future Rocky Mountain College students may now participate in the Army ROTC program while enrolled at Rocky.

Rocky has recently become an affiliate campus for the Montana State University-Bozeman Army ROTC program.

Leadership training and physical fitness training taken through the ROTC program will be awarded academic credit that will count toward a Rocky degree and will be transcribed as a Rocky course.

Students accepted into the ROTC program will be required to take coursework specific to the ROTC program, which will be administered on the MSU-Billings campus, as well as attend physical fitness training which will be conducted on both campuses.

MSU-Billings is also an affiliate campus for the MSU-Bozeman Army ROTC program.
