recognizing, honoring and celebrating the accomplishments of their students.

At the reception 43 students will receive scholarships and be asked to speak  
briefly about the challenges they have overcome in pursuit of a college degree.

Guest speaker will be Pam Bucy, Executive Assistant Attorney General of the  
State of Montana, a 1991 RMC graduate and first-generation student, who is a  
candidate for Montana Attorney General. Bucy graduated with honors from  
Rocky Mountain College in Billings in 1991 with degrees in history, political  
science and English. Bucy graduated with honors from the University of  
Montana School of Law in 1998.

TRiO is the acronym given by Congress to a series of federally-funded  
programs to help first generation, low-income students, and those with  
disabilities, be successful in college.
