Chris Stutzriem was named the 18th head football coach in Rocky Mountain College history in December. Stutzriem is returning to Rocky after serving as an assistant at Southwestern Oklahoma State University, a NCAA Division II program, for the past season. Prior to that, he served two years as the Rocky Mountain College offensive coordinator under Petrino. Stutzriem first came to Rocky after spending three seasons as the offensive coordinator at William Penn University.



The goal of the Battlin' Bears Youth Football Camp is to teach fundamentals in football according to each position, such as proper blocking and tackling techniques that focus on safety and head placement. It's critical to make sure the head stays out of all contact just like it is taught by the NFL-sponsored Heads Up Football program. Also emphasized will be proper footwork and ball skills that go along with throwing, catching, and running with the football.
