Message from the Director

The library started the school year with a Solar Eclipse Party organized by Alana Mueller, Assistant Library Director. The party was a huge success with many students, faculty, staff and community members attending. The only regret the library had was not ordering enough special solar eclipse glasses. The demand was extremely heavy and we could have had several hundred more and still probably run out. Everyone was very gracious though and willing to share what we had available. We had ordered 100 of them. The library continues to have success with library instruction and is seeing a wide range of classes asking for this service. In addition to English 119 and Communications 102 we were able to conduct classes in Biology 120 another traditionally freshman class giving us further confidence that we are reaching many of our freshman students. The library added more than 160,000 e-books through our consortiums TRAILS* and WALDO. TRAILS negotiated an ebook package with Proquest covering a broad range of academic subjects. WALDO offered a package of ACLS** Humanities e-books. Alana Mueller, Assistant Library Director organized a faculty panel discussion revolving around the common read book Don't Trust, Don't Fear, Don't Beg. Tim Lehman, Jenifer Parks, and Jackie Webb were the panelists that made up the panel for this event for all freshman students. The event took place in Losekamp Hall on October 9, 2017. This year for International Week the library conducted and Origami workshop and paper airplane flying contest. The library provided the material and Beth Schatzke, Library Associate led the session with the help of Alum Charles Gavin. The library took possession of a Western Book Collection donated by Garald Krieg that consists of many first editions and rare books. There were a total of 932 books. It is the hope of the library to secure funding for appropriate shelving and make the collection available to researchers. Library staff continues to be involved with our TRAILS consortium and is utilizing more and more features of our library system ALMA.
