COVID-19 Student Emergency Grant Eligibility Requirements:

- Enrolled during any term on or after March 13, 2020, the date of declaration of the national emergency due to the coronavirus
- Experiencing or have experienced exceptional financial need resulting from coronavirus on or after March 13, 2020, the date of declaration of the national emergency due to the coronavirus including unemployment of a family member or independent student or other circumstances

COVID-19 Emergency Grant Guidelines:

- Emergency financial aid grants are allowed to be used by students for
 - Any component of their cost of attendance (including student account balance)
 - Emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus such as
 - Tuition
 - Food
 - Housing
 - Health Care (including Mental Health Care)
 - Childcare

Upon successful completion and submission of the COVID-19 Student Emergency Grant application with supporting documentation, your application will be reviewed to ensure compliance and eligibility. Once approved, available funds will be provided to the student.
