Library Staff

The library staff has been busy with many changes this past year. The library established a library advisory board consisting of faculty from various disciplines. This has been especially helpful with communicating back to departments what is happening in the library and receiving information from departments as to what they would like to see in the library. The library has also been involved with the renovation of the north side of the library into an academic learning center with the writing center and a math tutoring center planned for completion January 2016. The college as a whole went through the 7 year cycle of accreditation this year and the library is an integral part of this process. Initial feedback has been positive. A proxy server was implemented which will make remote access to library material much easier for our students. They will now have a single login versus various ones for each database. The library also finished implementation of Primo the library discovery service.
