Thank you for your interest in the Master of Educational Leadership Program at Rocky Mountain College. This accelerated program combines theory and practice and begins in early August on RMC's campus. Throughout the school year, your coursework and internship can be completed in your hometown. The program culminates with a residential capstone course on Rocky's campus in June. Candidates complete the Master's degree in eleven months by taking accelerated classes one night per week on Vision Net or in class.

The internship involves a building mentor and a college liaison that will assist in the implementation of applied theory through administration experiences. The certification will be a K-12 building or district leader.
