Online registration will open for you after 12:15 am on the following dates:

- **Monday, April 13:** 90+ credits earned (currently a senior)
- **Tuesday, April 14:** 60–89 credits earned (currently a junior)
- **Wednesday, April 15:** 27-59 credits earned (currently a sophomore)
- **Thursday, April 16:** 0-26 credits earned (currently a freshman)
